SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing personal information. (BDR 52-756)

AN ACT relating to the security of personal information; expanding the definition of "personal information"; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law defines the types of information that constitute "personal information" for the purpose of requiring business entities who collect such information to provide certain security measures to ensure the protection of the information. (Chapter 603A of NRS) This bill expands the definition of "personal information" to include such items of information as electronic mail addresses and passwords, passport numbers, medical and health insurance identification numbers, electronic signatures and other similar information that would increase a person's likelihood of becoming a victim of identity theft.
